Community Improvement Fund.

The main purpose of the meeting was to agree the content of the bid to Surrey County Council for funding from the Community Improvement Fund for improvements to Town Path, so that the bid might be submitted by the closing date of 15 July. Prior to the meeting all members of the team had been sent the following information: Community Improvements Fund - criteria, guidance and application form, and information on potential improvements to Town Path to go on the website. Rachel Raynaud provided a summary of potential project ideas to include in the bid and possible costs.

It was agreed that the following items would be included in the bid and that the ETT would provide a 10% contribution to the total bid cost:

- Street mural on gable end wall of 66 High Street
- Potential second mural on the side of the model railway club subject to permission from the club - Clive Walker confirmed that he would contact them
- Bench and planter
- Usb charger unit
- Additional flag pole holders

The team did not support the idea of including new compacting bins in the bid due to their cost.

taxi licensing rewritten bylaws & conditions

Bill Bessant informed the team about a current consultation being undertaken by the Council on taxi bylaws and conditions, and expressed concern that parts of this could result in more hardship for the independent local Egham taxi drivers.
